Dr. Humayun Murshed

Dr. Murshed having wealth of experience in both academia and industry is currently working with the Study Group. He is responsible for leading and managing the delivery of accounting programmes of Charles Sturt University through its Study Centres in Brisbane, Melbourne and Sydney, Australia. He holds the position of Adjunct Associate Professor at the School of Accounting and Finance under the Faculty of Business, Justice and Behavioural Sciences of Charles Sturt University. Dr. Murshed holds Ph.D. from the University of Manchester, UK; and is a member of CPA Australia. His professional experience includes working as Associate Professor at Murdoch University, Australia; staff member (STT) of the World Bank; Head of School of Management Studies at the University of Brunei Darussalam and Chairman, Department of Finance, University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. During his academic tenures, Dr. Murshed has led various initiatives, including new course and curriculum development in Business, establishment of industry networking centres, and industry placements for tertiary students.
